**Shipadmin upgrades software systems**  
(Oct 14 2010)

Norwegian company Shipadmin has released new versions of its software systems, with Captains Secretary 2.1 and the corresponding FleetManager 2.1 now commercially available.

The company says that the software has been upgraded in close cooperation with users, and has new added features to improve documentation and reporting processes.

The Captains Secretary 2.1 system includes improvements in managing Daily Figures (such as logging of consumption and running hours for engines, thrusters, fuel, and oil types), NOx calculation (including the Norwegian NOx tax), and restriction on user access dependent on personal permissions.

The new version also includes a module for the generation of custom-made reports, and for the creation of an embarkation history for ports and terminals.

The FleetManager 2.1 package for the shore office includes improved incident reporting, as well as access to information created within the new version of the Captains Secretary product.

"We realise that having your documentation and reports in order and being able to have hands on-knowledge of your vessels' status – at any given time – is a great and time consuming challenge today," said Per Magnus Grøsvik, general manager, Shipadmin.

"Shipadmin aims to make what could become a plunge into a brief affair – and the features added, or upgraded, in this version have all been made as a result of our close cooperation with our clients. This is the only way to work for us at Shipadmin."

Shipadmin clients will receive the upgraded versions of the system free of charge, a group which will include Oceanic Vega, an X-bowed seismic research vessel which has recently signed up to install the Captains Secretary system.

The vessel is the fourth vessel owned or managed by Eidesvik to implement Shipadmin software.

"Eidesvik has confirmed that we have the solutions they need in their daily operation of their most complex vessels," said Mr Grøsvik.

"I am proud to work with a professional and innovative company like Eidesvik."
